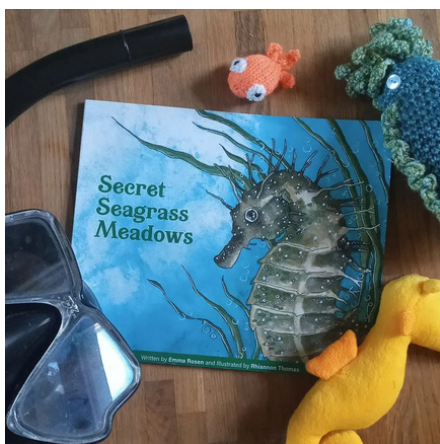

Brightly-coloured illustrations of animals accompanying a conversation between an aunt and niece about how mammals feed their babies



Mummy takes Tilly (and some freshly baked cookies) to meet Uncle James and Auntie Grace's new baby. When Tilly first sees baby Ben she wonders why he's snuggled up so closely to Auntie Grace. Luckily, her aunt knows all sorts of funny facts about how different kinds of animals give their babies milk, which helps Tilly understand what breastfeeding is.

This is a heartwarming story for little ones to share with their families and it makes space for deeper conversations about what happens when a new baby comes along.

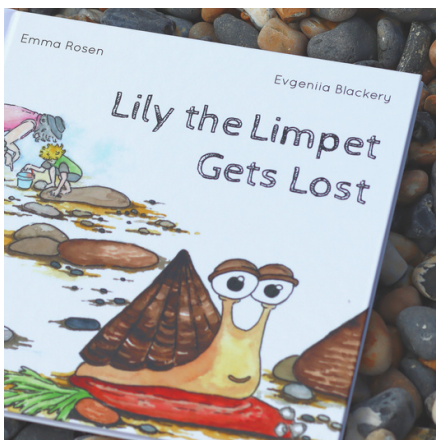

Students also have the option to buy books if they wish (order form sent prior to visit).

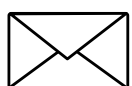
Half Day B £100

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# Author Visit Sessions

Emma offers school visits to primary schools, secondary schools and nurseries, which can be fully tailored to different ages, curricula or interests.

## Storytelling (EYFS/KS1)

- Introduction to Emma and her books.
- An interactive book reading.
- An opportunity for children to ask questions.

(This session can be extended with activities around the book (singing/colouring/crafting/writing) depending on the timeframe available)

## Creative writing KS2/KS1

- Introduction to Emma and her books, including where she gets her ideas from.
- An interactive book reading.
- Creative stimuli given out and idea generation session in small groups.
- Children are supported by Emma to write their own stories.(appropriate to their age).
- An opportunity for children to share their work and ask questions.

## Author (career) talk KS2/KS3/KS4/KS5

- Introduction to Emma and her career so far.
- Discussion of how a book is created (this can be tied in to activities such as learning editing skills, or move into a creative writing session).
- An opportunity for students to ask questions.

## Other sessions Emma can run:

Assemblies.

Editing workshops.

Marine biology sessions (focussing on habitats, wildlife and protecting the environment).

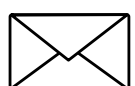
Making mini rockpools.
